

Instruction Manual

MAIN UNIT



FEATURES

Receiving RC time automatically (DCF only).
Calendar from 2000 – 2099.

Indoor temperature range: 0°C - 50°C.

- 7 language weekdays display:
- English, German, French, Italian, Dutch, Spanish, Denmark.

 12/24 hours selectable
- 12/24 nours selectable.
 Alarm & Snooze functions
- LED backlight
 Temperature display.

BATTERY INSTALLATION 1. Remove the battery cover.

- Insert 1 X AA battery.
- Replace cover.

SET TIME

AUTOMATIC
Once the battery is installed, the clock will begin searching for a signal. Within 3-8 minutes the clock will receive the RC signal and set itself to the correct time.

MANUAL

- Press and hold "SET" key for 2 seconds to enter into time setting mode.
- 2. The figure to be set will flash.
- Press "UP" or "DOWN" key to change the time/date.
 The order is: 12/24-hr format. Time zone. Hour. Minute. Year. Month. Date.
- language weekdays. 5. Press "SET" again to confirm.
- If you want to switch to auto mode then press "WAVE" to save & exit. This will revert to the RC mode.
- If no keys are pressed for 30 seconds, it will automatically exit to the time mode.

ALARM & SNOOZE

AI ARM

- Press "ALARM" once to switch alarm on/off.

 indicate alarm is on.
- Hold "ALARM" key for 2 seconds to enter into alarm setting mode. 3. The figure to be set will flash.
- Press "UP" or "DOWN" to change the alarm.
- 5. The order is: Hour → Minute
- 6. Press "ALARM" again to confirm and exit setting mode.
- If no keys are pressed for 30 seconds, it will automatically save the new values and exit to time mode

SNOOZE FUNCTION

Alarm ring:

a) Duration: 2 mins.

b) Ringing:

11 – 20	2		
21 - 30	4		
> 30	Continuoue		

c) When alarm ringing, press "SNOOZE/LIGHT" key once for a 5-min snooze time. the "zz"will flash, press any other key will cancel snooze, but alarm ring again after 24 hours.

TEMPERATURE

- The indoor temperature will display within 3-8 minutes automatically after set up.
- Press "DOWN" to switch "C/"F.

RCC Receiving

RCC receiving condition:

- a. RC signal received automatically when starting up clock or reset. The clock will try to receive RC signal between 1 AM and 5 AM;
- b. On time mode, press "WAVE " key to enter into RC mode directly.
- c. RC signal receiving automatically every day:

RCC Receiving Icon:

- a. When attempting to detect RC signal or when signal is too weak, icon Wwill flash:
- b. When signal detected, icon ²⁰⁰ will flash:
- When signal successfully received, the icon will stop flashing.
- To cancel RC signal receiving, press "WAVE" key once.
- If no signal received on the day, it will try again at 1AM next day.
- If alarm rings while receiving RC signal, it will auto exit RC signal receiving.

When receive DST, the DST symbol will display on the LCD screen.
